

Information on the Language Exam

Foreign study applicants need to prove adequate knowledge of language, apart from the artistic aptitude test.

For the study course school music a „TestDaF-Certificate“ of Level 5 in all areas is required; for music pedagogy (instrumental and vocal pedagogy), Music Transmission (Sound Editor) and Artistic Harmony (Music Theory) the “TestDaF-Certificate” of Level 4 in all exam areas is required.

Those not in possession of this certificate of aptitude for the university may, after passing the artistic aptitude test prepare for this TestDaF Examination in one to maximum two language semesters at the university offered language course.

The university internal language examination in the framework of the aptitude tests will decide if the passing of the TestDaF-Examination in the time frame of one to two semesters is realistic.

Students of all artistic study courses need to prove language knowledge of a minimum Level B1 (Europarat), in the framework of the university internal language examination or through an existing certificate which has been supplied with one's application.

Foreign students without this proof of language knowledge, may after having passed the artistic aptitude test, in the framework of a language semester, learn the German language directly at the university in a specially offered language course.

On request and with sufficient participants, preparation courses (chargeable) may be run in the semester holidays.

Foreign study applicants, who have completed a German Abitur in their country of origin, are exempt from the language examination.

Guest students and students in the framework of the Erasmus Program may attend the language courses offered by KULTUR & KOMMUNIKATION at the Music Academy. Students are responsible for the course fees.
