

Room Regulations - Detmold University of Music

(September 2017)

- § 1 The teaching and practice rooms at the university are available to every member of Detmold University of Music for the purpose of practising, provided the room is not being used for classes (including vocal coaching) or by a member of the teaching staff.
- § 2 Every member is obliged to treat the instruments with care and consideration.
- § 3 Non-members are prohibited from practising in Detmold University of Music practice rooms. Rehearsals of mixed member/non-member ensembles are permitted. There will be unannounced checks, and every student must show their student ID if requested to do so.
- § 4 Practice sessions last for
 - up to 2 hours on the piano floor,
 - up to 3 hours in every other room.
- § 5 Students must enter their name, matriculation number and intended practice time legibly in the booking plan.
- § 6 Signing up is only allowed for the practice session immediately following the current one. Students may not reserve more than one room at a time, nor may they reserve the next practice session while their current session is still in progress. It is also not permitted to reserve on behalf of other students, or to book a morning practice session the previous evening.
- § 7 Rehearsals must be booked at least one day in advance. A rehearsal may be reserved on the condition that at least two people take part. Students are expected to enter the names of all participants, and the matriculation number of at least one participant, otherwise the room may be used by other students.
- § 8 The claim to a reserved practice session expires if the room is not in use for 15 minutes during that time. In this case, the room may be used by other students.
- § 9 Rooms may not be blocked by placing bags, clothes, scores etc. against the door.
- § 10 Piano practice takes priority on the piano floor. The same applies to practising the accordion in E15. These rooms must be given up immediately to students of those instruments if required.
- § 11 Rooms listed in the online booking plan are subject to separate rules.

Note:

Please leave the door open when you leave a room, and be fair towards other students!
